

DISEASE PAMPHLET

STUDENT LEARNING OBJECTIVE

1. Students will be able to use online resources to gather sufficient information necessary to construct a pamphlet on a specific bacterial or viral disease.

MATERIALS

Computer with internet access
Construction paper, tape, glue, color pencils, stapler

PROCEDURES

Disease Research: (50 min)

Each student chooses either a bacterial or viral disease from a list provided by the teacher. Students meet in the media center (Library) and use the computers to find information on their specific disease. Students can use any information to present their disease, but before the end of class they must at least have information on the following: whether the disease is caused by a bacterium (which organism) or virus, mode of transmission, signs and symptoms, treatment, long-term prognosis, and prevention.

Disease Pamphlet: (50 min)

Students use the information they collected and available materials to construct their disease pamphlet during class. For students using computer software to create their pamphlets, they should be storyboarding their ideas on plain paper.

Each student will turn in a disease pamphlet
